

A Note from Father Mike

Hello from Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH... © You may have noticed that I am not at St. Mary Magdalene at the moment. I am taking a two-week course up here for spiritual directors. I am starting the first part of a three-year certification program. A spiritual director is someone who helps the faithful to grow deeper in their relationship with God by seeking Him with their whole being through prayer and discerning how He is calling them and working within them to grow in holiness.

Franciscan University's campus is a beautiful place. It has lots of hills, so walking around campus feels like I am on a nonstop Stairmaster at a gym. I think it is one of a few Catholic universities that has not traded its Catholic Identity to fit in better with the secular society. There are crucifixes in the classrooms and all around the campus. Mother Mary and the rosary are also seen all around the campus. The Holy Spirit is actively at work in this university.

In the first reading this weekend, we also hear of the Holy Spirit at work in the early Church. The first major controversy in the early Church was about "what one must do to be saved." For the first couple dozen years of the early Church, all Jesus' followers were Jewish. During that time, any Gentiles who wanted to become Jesus' disciples were expected first to become Jews. This issue could not be settled on a local level, although Paul and Barnabas tried that at first. Thus, they had to go to Jerusalem to consult the apostles. The apostles convened the first Church Council at Jerusalem and, with the clear leading of the Holy Spirit, decided that the gentiles did not need to become Jews first to be saved as Christians.

Let us always remember that God never abandons us or leaves us alone. He loves us immensely and gives us the Holy Spirit, who will teach and guide us in everything we need to know. Our Lord also gives us His peace to strengthen us against any fears or troubles we may encounter in life. Keep the faith, and I will see you all again soon.
